- ❖ **Saturday January 26th** : **“Lunar New Year Lion Dancing: Traveling Festival”** Celebrate the Lunar New Year with a mini traveling festival of free lion dancing performance. 3 pm- 3:30 pm. Ocean View Branch Library | 345 Randolph Street, Ingleside.
- ❖ **Sunday January 27th** : **“Point Bonita Lighthouse Tour”** Meet Point Bonita docents along the lighthouse trail. This hidden, historic setting offers breathtaking views and many stories of what was life like living at the head of such perilous waters. Built in 1855, this secret jewel of the Bay Area is the third lighthouse built on the West Coast and helped shepherd ships through the treacherous Golden Gate straights. Today, the lighthouse is still active and is maintained by the US Coast Guard. 12:30 pm-3:30 pm. Point Bonita | Marine Headlands. Cost: Free.

- ❖ **Ongoing: Exploratorium** It isn't just a museum. It's an ongoing exploration of science, art, and human perception. A vast collection of online experiences that feed your curiosity. Sat-Thurs: 10am- 5pm; Thurs night : 6-10pm (+18 yrs. only); Fri: 10am- 9pm. exploratorium.edu
- ❖ **Ongoing: SF MOMA** The newly-transformed and expanded San Francisco Museum of Modern Art has been built to showcase the museum's celebrated collection over ten breathtaking floors. Fri-Tues: 10am-5pm; Thurs: 10am-9pm.

- ❖ **Ongoing: Organ Concerts** The Legion of Honor's Skinner Organ (Circa 1924) is a spectacular musical instrument created by one of America's most distinguished organ builders. View extraordinary works of art as you listen to a free concert, held every Saturday and Sunday that the museum is open at 4pm.
- ❖ **Ongoing: Botanical Garden** (formerly Strybing Arboretum) A living museum within Golden Gate Park offering 55 acres of both landscaped gardens and open spaces and showcasing over 8,000 different kinds of plants from around the world. Open 7:30am-6pm daily. sfbotanicalgarden.org
- ❖ **Ongoing: California Academy of Sciences** Based in Golden Gate Park, it is home to a world-class aquarium, planetarium and natural history museum all under one living roof! Open: Sunday 11am-5pm; Mon-Sat 9:30am-5pm.
- ❖ **Ongoing: Muir Woods** Walk among ancient coastal redwoods (some of the oldest and tallest trees in the world!) cooling their roots in the fresh water of Redwood Creek and lifting their crowns to reach the sun and fog. Open daily: 8am-5pm. Ask your concierge for the best way to get there.
- ❖ **Ongoing: Off the Grid Friday Night Food Truck Party at Fort Mason** (2 Marina Blvd) Enjoy approximately 30 gourmet food trucks, tents, and dessert carts plus cocktails, wine bar, and a beer garden while listening to live music. 5-10pm every Friday.
